

**REPORT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF MISSION& EVANGELISM OF THE GA WEST PRESBYTERY
COVERING THE PERIOD JANUARY TO 31ST DECEMBER, 2025 SUBMITTED TO THE 10TH PRESBYTERY
SESSION HELD FROM 23RD APRIL TO 26TH APRIL, 2026 AT THE TRINITY CONGREGATION,
KWASHIEMAN.**

Preamble

Introduction

The main preoccupation of this report is to highlight the activities of the Department of Mission and Evangelism and its stakeholder within the Ga West Presbytery from 1st January to 31st December, 2025.

Notable Events

1. BIBLE STUDY AND PRAYER GROUP 2025 PRESBYTERIAL CONVENTION

The Ga West Presbytery's BSPG held its 2025 Convention at the Odorkor Police Interdenominational Church premises from Thursday 2nd to Sunday 5th January, 2025 on the theme "CELEBRATING OUR HERITAGE: PERSISTING IN MISSION- EVANGELIZE AND DISCIPLE". The Mission and Evangelism Director, Rev. David S. Obli was the main Speaker for the Convention. Other speakers included the Presbytery Chairperson, Rev. Pobebe, Rev. Charles Adom Darkwa and Rev. Samuel Adom Adja. The attendance at the 2025 BSPG convention was very impressive. The Chairperson preached the sermon on the last day of the convention, Sunday, 5th January, 2025.

2. NATIONAL PRAYER MARATHON

On the 12th January, 2025 the Ga West Presbytery participated in the Annual Prayer Marathon organized by the Department of Mission & Evangelism at the National Level. The Presbytery was represented by the Nyonmo Dromo congregation at Korobite and led by the Prayer Centre director, Rev. Nicholas Aryee to pray from 2:00pm -3:00pm.

The M&E Department at the National level provided prayer topics that guided the prayer sessions. The theme for the 2025 edition was CELEBRATING OUR HERITATAGE: PERSISTING IN MISSION THROUGH PRAYER. The prayers were beamed live on the various PCG Social Media platforms as well as on PCG TV.

3. EVANGELISM AND CHURCH GROWTH CONSULTATION

The Ga West Presbytery held its first Evangelism Consultation on Friday 28th February, 2025 at the Eternity congregation at Apenkwa with two resource persons namely Rev. Abraham Opoku Baffour and Catechist Martin Osei Buabeng. The theme of the Consultation for was "Persisting in Mission: The Heart of The Presbyterian Missionary.

Rev. Abraham Opoku Baffour spoke about building a mission minded church and gave fifteen mission areas that could be considered by the districts as they embark on evangelism which is the core-mandate of the church. Catechist Buabeng on the other hand based his talk on the planting and nurturing of churches in the Ga West Mission Field and stressed the need to be intentional and diligent.

4. MISSION AND EVANGELISM DIRECTORS' ANNUAL RETREAT:

The M&E Director, Rev. Obli participated in the annual retreat held at Sunyani in the Brong-Ahafo Presbytery from Tuesday 11th March to Thursday 13th March. The retreat concerned itself with prayer in support of the first ever PCG National Crusade and departmental collaboration in evangelism.

5. PCG NATIONAL CRUSADE

The M&E Department at the National level in collaboration with the B.A. Presbytery organized the long awaited PCG National Crusade at the Sunyani Jubilee Park from Wednesday 12th to Friday 14th March 2025. The Crusade which was beamed live on the various PCG Social Media platforms and PCG TV was attended by more than three thousand people. The principal officers of the church, namely the moderator and Clerk of the General Assembly and several General Assembly Council Members were in attendance. The main speaker of the Crusade was Rev. Abraham Opoku Baffour, a Presbyterian minister seconded to the Asbury Dunwell Church at Ridge in Accra. The Ga West Presbytery was represented by Rev. David S. Obli, its M&E director.

6. LAUNCHING OF THE 2025 EVANGELISM WEEK OF THE PCG

The Moderator of the PCG, Right Rev. Dr. Abraham Nana Opare Kwakye assisted by GAC members launched the PCG 2025 Evangelism Week at the Emmanuel Congregation at Sunyani on Sunday 16th March during the fore-noon service. The various presbyteries donated a total of one hundred and forty six (146) motorbikes to Agents of the church in less endowed communities. The occasion was witnessed by several chiefs and queen mothers of various communities within the presbytery.

7. CHAIRPERSON'S RETREAT WITH DISTRICT MINISTERS AND THEIR SPOUSES

The Chairperson and Clerk of Presbytery hosted District Ministers and their wives to a retreat at the Akuapem Presbytery Hospitality Centre at Akropong to strategize on how to achieve the presbyteries set goals and targets. The Resource persons for the retreat were Rev. Enoch Pobee, Rev. Gideon Pupilampu and Dr. Mrs. Beatrice Odonkor. The retreat also afforded Ministers and their spouses to pray about a wide range of issues and also fraternize.

8. **Church planting survey by Sakaman District:** The Sakaman District led by Rev. Dr. Amfo Akonnor explored the Parks and Gardens sprawling community within the Adjen Kotoku district in conjunction with the Presbytery M&E Director, Rev. D.S. Obli and a delegation from the Adjen Kotoku District led by Rev. Asare-Nkansah (DM). A temporal place of worship was identified and plans are underway to plant the church.

9. **Church planting survey by NUPS-G & Manhean Sub-District:** The National Union of Presbyterian Students Ghana (NUPS-G) from the University of Profession Studies (UPSA) Accra embarked on church planting feasibility tour of the Peace Village Community in the Manhean Sub-District and identified two places where PCG Churches could be planted.

North Outreach Church Planting and Nurturing at Agboghloshie: The Love Congregation (NOP) spearheaded the planting of a Preaching Point at Agboghloshie Market and has been

nurturing it with the support of the Mamprobi district. The District acquired and paid for a rental premises as their worshipping place.

10. **Revitalization of Akutiaku Preaching Point:** The Mamprobi District has revitalized the Akutiaku Preaching Point that had almost collapsed. The Caretaker, Cat. Emmanuel Kwame Bamfo has been housed by Mamprobi District, making it easier for him to perform his duties. Besides, the Mamprobi District also donated brand new polo T-Shirts and used clothing to every member of the Akutiaku preaching point. The district also provided a chronicle book to the preaching point.
11. **New Achimota District Mission to Kofi Donkor:** The New Achimota District continued its mission to Kofi Donkor by spending a couple of weekends in the community and undertaking house-to-house evangelism and donating clothing, fuzzy drinks and pastries to the members.
12. **Police Cells Ministry:** The New Achimota district has been undertaking vigorous Police Cells evangelism at the Mile 7, Taifa, Kwabenya and Pokuase Police Stations, where they shared Christian literature and also fed the inmates. The Presbytery BSPG also embarked upon Cells Ministry at the Odorkor Police Station Cells.
13. **Evangelism Consultation by the Adabraka Official Town District:** The Adabraka Official Town District held a day's Evangelism Consultation at the Ebenezer congregation at Abossey Okai on Saturday 17th May, 2025. Rev. David Obli was the resource person.
14. **Presbytery BSPG 9TH Conference was held at the Calvary congregation in the Sarpeiman district on Saturday 31st May, 2025.** The M&E directed who represented the Chairperson and Clerk of Presbytery gave the keynote address. The Rev. Bernard Omari Kwakye, the Sarpeiman District Minister did the official opening of the conference.
15. **Presbytery Catechist Conference:** The M&E director, Rev. Obli encouraged the 2025 catechists' conference to emulate the example of the presbytery Women's Fellowship by planting and nurturing a church for the PCG as their contribution to the realization of the Agenda 2 million project of the PCG. The conference was held at the Emmanuel congregation at Dansoman on Saturday 28th June 2025.
16. **Church planting at Peace Village Eye of God near the Trotro station in the Manhean Sub-District:** The National Union of Presbyterian Students Ghana (NUPS-G) from the University of Professional Studies (UPSA) Accra in a collaborative venture with the Manhean Sub-District planted a church on Sunday, 29th June 2025 after a week-long house-to-house evangelism. Rev. Obli preached during the maiden service and has since been providing refreshment for members of the new church. Catechist Nelson Etornam Tse has been put in charge of the new church.
17. **Church planting by Sakaman District:** The Sakaman District on Sunday 14th September, 2025 planted a church at Krokohwe in the Ashalaja Sub-District. The District Minister, Rev. Dr. Kofi Amfo Akonnor with the support of the Sakaman District Council and the Ashalaja Sub-District established the preaching point after vigorous evangelistic activities. The maiden service was attended by twelve (12) adults members and One-hundred and twenty-two (122) children. Mr. Isaac Asuah of Calvary congregation in the Sakaman District was appointed as the caretaker of the newly planted church.
18. **New Achimota District Mission to Kofi Donkor:** The New Achimota District has been continuing its mission to Kofi Donkor by spending a couple of weekends in the community and undertaking house-to-house evangelism and donating clothing, fuzzy drinks and pastries to the members.

- 19. New Achimota District Mission Surveying of Gakope-Ahiabu and Obotan for Church planting:** The New Achimota District surveyed Gakope, Ahiabu and Obotan communities in the Adjen Kotoku District for the planting of a Presbyterian there. The Evangelism team was warmly received by members of the community. The team embarked on house-to-house witnessing on Friday 19th and Saturday 20th December 2025 and planted the church on Sunday 21st December, 2025
- 20. 2nd Mission and Evangelism Consultation:** Ga west Presbytery Mission & Evangelism Department under the auspices of the Presbytery Session Council organised its second Evangelism and Church Growth Consultation at the Eternity congregation at Apenkwa from 21st to 23rd October, 2025. The resource persons were Rev. Abraham Opoku Baffour, Rev. Dr. Emmanuel Sarbah, National Director of M&E and Rev. Andrew Shardow, Director of Church Life and Nurture.
- 21. Church planting at Afuaman New Site in the Manhean Sub-District:** The Presbyterian Youth in Church Evangelism Team (P-YICE) of the Ga West Presbytery collaborated with the Manhean Sub-District and planted a church on Sunday, 6th December 2025 after a week-long house-to-house evangelism by the youth in the Afuaman New Site community. The youth numbering about sixty (60) participated in the maiden service. Rev. Obli, Mr. Obodai Torgbor and Mr. David Gorleku participated in the surveying and planting of the church referred to as the Ga West Presbytery 10th Anniversary Church. Rev. Obli introduced Mr. Charles Lartey a member of the Peace congregation at Peace Village as the Caretaker of the newly planted church at the maiden service. The church meets for worship at the private residence of Rev. Michael Addoquaye Addo, the New Achimota District Minister at Afuaman New Site.
- 22. Church planting by Weija Gbawe District:** The Weija-Gbawe District planted a church at Jei Krodua after vigorous evangelistic activities including film shows, Dawn Broadcasts, House to house witnessing and games from 25th to 28th December, 2025. The church has a total of One hundred and twenty-two (122) souls comprising of fifteen (15) adults and seventy-nine (79) children.
- 23. New Weija District planted three (3) churches:** The New Weija District planted two (2) churches in the 4th quarter of 2025. The first church was planted on 21st December by Amazing Grace congregation at Tomefa and has been Christened Christ preaching point.
- 24.** The second was planted at Azumah Top at Sunny Coast on 28th December 2025, and it has 18 members, 6 adult, 4 Junior Youth and 8 children.
- 25.** A third one that was named Ebenezer preaching point was actually planted in February 2024 by Amazing Grace congregation at a place called Yellow Container and now has 48 members.
- 26. New Achimota District Mission planted a church at Gakope-Ahiabu:** The New Achimota District has planted a church at Gakope-Ahiabu-Obotan communities in the Adjen Kotoku District.
- 27. Aplaku District Planted A Church At Amanfrom, Pentecost Area In The Fise District.**
- 28. Committee on Evangelism in-person Meeting:** The Committee on Evangelism met at the Family Chapel for its end of year stocktaking and evaluation. Each of the 21 districts, the Mission Field and the two Sub-Districts were represented. The Presbytery director of M&E Rev. Obli was assisted by Rev. Maxwell Johnson Obodai Sai for the facilitation of the

meeting. The Clerk of Presbytery, Rev. Kennedy Asante Sarpong was the Special Guest of honour.

29. Evangelism Consultations:

Rev. Obli facilitated Evangelism for the Mamprobi and Manhean District in the period under review. Participants were encouraged to be aggressive in their evangelism drives and to embark on one-on- one evangelism more often.

30. BSPG Church Nurturing Activities: The Presbytery BSPG continued to nurture three preaching points at Botokrowa, Twerebo and Fankyenekor in the Adjen Kotoku District. The group has tirelessly brave the odds with limited resources kept the three churches running for over three years. **We recommend that the Presbytery support the BSPG with an annual grant to enable them to effectively nurture the three churches.**
